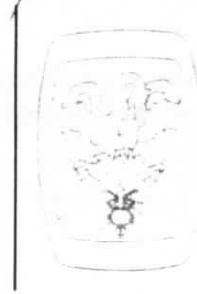

I am writing this letter in support of Christopher Nabors who was recently convicted of vehicular homicide here in New Orleans. I have gotten to know Dr. Nabors quite well over the past seven years, having been the secretary responsible for all necessary paperwork involved with Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery residency. I have been employed as the Department Head's secretary at LSU School of Dentistry since 1986. Since I have known Dr. Nabors he has obtained first a Ph.D. degree in Anatomy, a medical degree, and completed one year of the Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery residency. He has three more years until completion of his residency.

In my line of work I run across many types of personalities. Dr. Nabors appeared to be a somewhat shy person who mainly kept to himself in the beginning of our acquaintance, however, with time I came to know him as a nice, courteous, personable and responsible individual. I also believe him to be a dedicated individual.

Dedication is a hard thing to come by these days and I believe individuals who dedicate years of their lives to gain the education and knowledge it takes to help and care for others are somewhat special people. However, dedication does not prevent people from making mistakes. A mistake has been made which resulted in a very unfortunate accident.

As a mother of four with one on the way I can only imagine the devastation felt by the parents of the young lady who drowned. However, knowing Dr. Nabors to be the type of person I believe him to be, makes me know he could not and did not intentionally harm or kill another individual.

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I can only hope on the day of sentencing that the court takes into consideration the dedication that Dr. Christopher Nabors has exhibited over the years and punishment is set accordingly.
