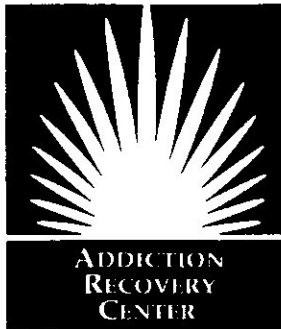

Dear Judge Waldron:

I am writing this letter to advise you that Chris Nabors meets the criteria for inpatient treatment at Palmetto Addiction Recovery Center. We are prepared to accept him upon his release from incarceration.

Palmetto provides a comprehensive substance abuse treatment facility. We believe the key to successful treatment is careful evaluation. Each client undergoes a medical examine to identify any medical problems that have resulted from substance abuse and to properly manage any concurrent medical conditions. This will be followed by a thorough psychosocial evaluation to identify those problems that must be addressed in Chris Nabors's substance abuse treatment. We will develop an individual treatment plan for Chris Nabors. Palmetto will include group, individual and family psychotherapy and educational lectures. Daily attendance at a 12-step meeting is mandatory.

Palmetto provides a special program to meet the specific needs of impaired professionals. Therapy and education in our program focus on living with sobriety, care giving, caretaker, work addiction, career adjustment issues and restoring a balanced lifestyle. The length of stay for impaired professional is a minimum of 2 months and up to 5 months (average length of stay is 3 months).
