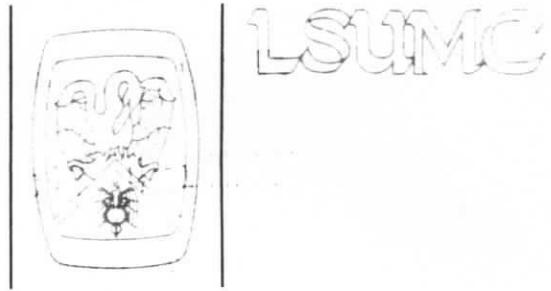

Re: Christopher Nabors

This petition is a request of compassion for Christopher Nabors. I am a clinical professor in the Oral and Maxillofacial department with direct daily supervision and observation of this trainee. He worked directly for me from May through June 1995 and intermittently since that time.

His actions with patients and his fellow men and women has been one of caring and the best interest of all concerned. My first point is that his affect and bearing as somewhat expressionless does not reflect his inner feelings or actions to his fellow man. He has been maligned for his lack of remorse and ill feelings expressed by those sympathetic to the deceased. He has been depressed and has tried to hide his inner most feelings wearing the mask of not caring. He has expressed a worthlessness so contrary to one with intense educational and as well as family values.

If you want to destroy this person, sentence him to prison, but if it is repayment for egregious behavior is what is due, then have him do medical service for the state of Louisiana in some capacity as a GMO for those less fortunate or in prison with the minimal income (above poverty level). I understand part of his sentence is statutorial but you may have some discretion about timing. His behavior could be monitored both during and after with reports from supervisors, probation officers, etc. Punish the act made by the person, but don't destroy the person with whom society has invested so heavily.
