16 Let me do, as a courtesy, do you need
17 a short break, please? And you're not in any
18 way causing any problem if your answer is
19 "yes."

20 (BRIEF PAUSE IN PROCEEDINGS)

21 THE COURT:

22 You may proceed, Mr. Kennedy.

23 MR. KENNEDY:

24 Thank you, Your Honor.

25 EXAMINATION

26 BY MR. KENNEDY:

27 Q. Dr. Nabors, I just have one area that was not
28 cleared up by your testimony.

29 And you admit to your drinking the entire evening;
30 that's correct?

31 A. Yes, sir.

32 Q. And that you had done shots and had been drinking

1 at Ernst Cafe and then at the Parkway, as well?

2 A. Yes, sir.

3 Q. How is it, then, that the blood that got tested at
4 Charity Hospital only came up a .04? What happened at
5 Charity?

6 A. I don't know what happened, but, I mean, the --
7 the only thing I could do is speculate, like any of the
8 other physicians that have been up here. I realize
9 that the -- the numbers that were -- you know, that
10 came up for the electrolytes and things like that, made
11 no sense. And it didn't make any sense to me that
12 there was lithium in the sample and, you know, that --
13 obviously, there was something wrong with the number.

14 Q. And you have no idea at all what it was that was
15 wrong with it?

16 A. I'm sorry?
